- II. Treasurers Report:
 - a. Need to review quantity of checks written for small dollar amounts to balance with expense of cutting checks and mailing. This is evident for those checks written for one-game scorekeeper (less than \$10.00).
 - b. SESR is caught up with the district however we have not yet received reimbursement for basketball.

- IV. Recap of recent board decisions
 - a. Eagle Scout project to replace concrete and dugout approved and scheduled for March 27th or April 10th

 - a. Gym floor was treated with sticky substance for basketball. Reports were positive, consider using it for volleyball.

- VII. CYC District Meeting Report
 - a. John Berger is our new CYC representative
 - b. Launched new district website
 - c. Executive positions are open
 - d. Online sign-up software is free for 6 months then will be \$2 per player. Need to compare this cost to the license fee structure of EZRoster.
 - e. Six proposed changes to the St. Louis CYC rules were discussed.
 - i. Definition of playoffs must be in 5 – 8 grades. SESR to vote yes on this amendment
 - ii. Rule stating if school holds tryouts for their CYC teams, only those players within the parish can tryout – SESR to vote yes on this amendment (St. Charles district does not allow tryouts)
 - iii. Change stating if team is short players, still forfeit game but can bring in guest players. SESR to vote no on this amendment.

- iv. Remove open/closed designation for playoffs and split schools based on size. SESR to vote no on this amendment
 - v. Remove open/close designation from all teams. SESR to vote no on this amendment.
 - f. District Volleyball coordinator still needed.
- VIII. Sports Coordinator Reports
 - a. Basketball –
 - i. Trophies will be awarded for division winner and/or playoff representative
 - 1. Likely have 3 teams win their division
 - ii. Appeal meeting was held and a coach 2 game suspension was upheld.
 - b. Umpires – no report
 - c. Equipment – need new equipment coordinator
 - d. Baseball/Softball
 - i. Playoffs scheduled for July 24 – August 1st
 - ii. Season starts April 26th – will play Memorial Day weekend, but not 4th of July.
 - iii. SESR Spring Classic has about the same number of teams as 2009 tourney.
 - iv. Wedding scheduled weekend of tournament so parking could be an issue.
 - e. Soccer
 - i. New rules that 2 yellow cards in certain number of days will be automatic suspension.

 - i. Rufkahr donated bobcat for field work, Board approved gift card as token of gratitude.
 - ii. Field 1 and 2 are good
 - iii. Field 3 is usable but rough
 - iv. Given \$800 budget for field day, suggested to have list of projects to ensure all are put to work when they volunteer.
